# Information About the Conference and Workshop

## Conference and Workshop Venue

The *First IP & Innovation Researchers of Asia Conference and Workshop for IP Teachers and Researchers* will be held at Ahmad Ibrahim Kulliyah of Laws of the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) – locally known as University Islam Antarabangsa (UIA).

The Opening, Plenary Sessions, and Keynotes parts of the Conference will take place in the Moot Court of the Ahmad Ibrahim Kulliyah of Laws. The Parallel Sessions will take place in designated rooms.

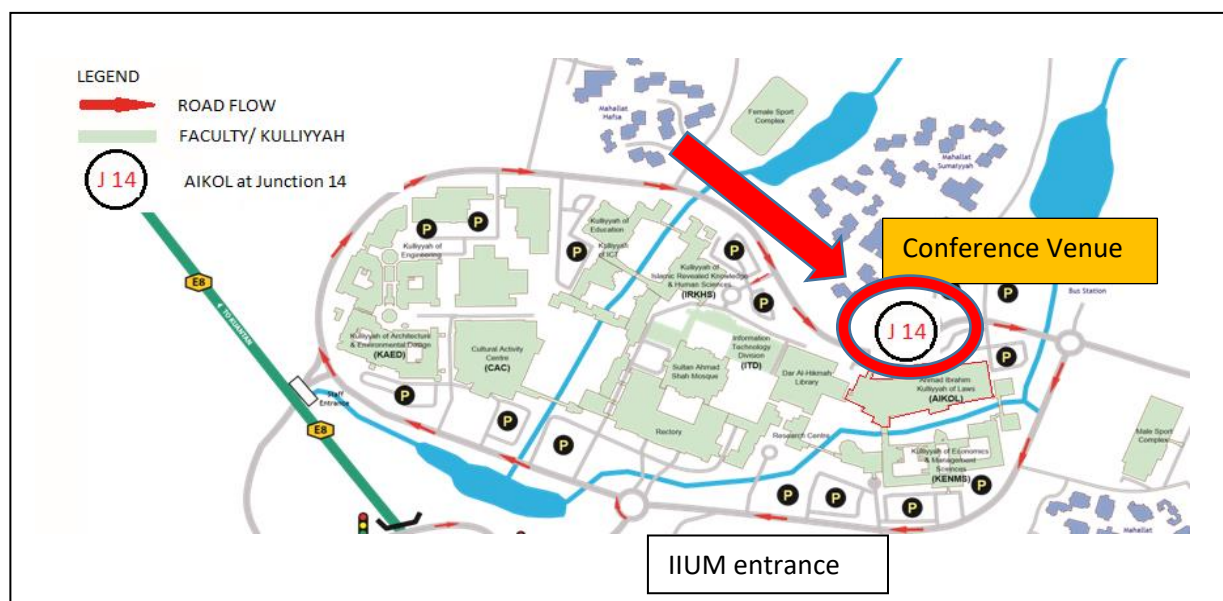

## **Transportation to the Conference and Workshop Venue**

### **Pick Up Buses**

IIUM has organized buses for participants from the Sunway Putra Hotel and Seri Pacific Hotel. Note that no other pick up buses will be available from other venues. Buses will wait outside these hotels with the signs “IPIRA 2019”. **The buses will depart from the hotels on time at 7.15 am. The buses will bring participants back to the same hotels in the evening.**

### **Driving**

We do not advise participants to drive. However, for those who prefer to use private transports, they are advised to display a temporary car sticker on the left side of the windscreen in order for the security guard to identify them as participants to the Conference. If you would like to drive and park your car please contact us and we will send you a sticker and instructions for reaching the visitor parking.

### **Taxis and Public Transport**

You can get to the IIUM campus either by taxi or public transport.

Please inform the taxi driver that you wish to go to University Islam Antarabangsa (UIA), Gombak, IIUM’s locally known name in the Malay Language. Taxi fare from KL City is approximately around RM21.00 - RM30.00 (5 - 8 USD)

Alternatively, you may like to take the Putra Light Rail Transit (Putra LRT) to **Terminal Putra Station** and hail a taxi from there.

### **Meals**

Tea breaks, lunches, and dinners will be served during the two days of the Conference and the half day of the Workshop. Specific instructions on the location of each meal are listed in the Program, which has been distributed as a separate file

### **Dress Code**

The dress code for the Conference and Workshop is business attire. Please note that the weather in Malaysia is hot and humid, yet the Conference venue may be cool due to air-conditioning and you may want to have a jacket or sweater handy.

## **Voltage and Power Plugs**

The standard voltage in Malaysia is 220V/240V, 50 Hz. If you have equipment that runs on a higher voltage, you should not connect it to the power unless you have the correct transformer (voltage adaptor).

Malaysia uses the British three-pronged square pin type socket. You are advised to bring along an international plug adaptor and/or transformer if required.

## **Internet Access**

Wifi guest access will be given to Conference and Workshop participants. Conference participants can also use wifi through the Eduroam network, which I enabled in the premises of IIUM.

# **Practical Travel Information**

## **Before Arrival**

For the International participants, please ensure that you have the following:

- ◆ Passport with at least 6 months' validity
- ◆ Sufficient funds for the duration of your stay in Malaysia
- ◆ A valid Malaysian entry visa (if applicable)

## **On Arrival**

Complete the Disembarkation/Embarkation form, which you will receive on the airplane. You should present this with your passport to the Immigration Officers at the airport. Retain the portion of the Disembarkation/Embarkation that will be given to you to be returned when you leave the country.

## **Getting to the Hotels**

Getting to and from the Kuala Lumpur International Airport is easy, convenient and relatively inexpensive. You have a choice of several modes of transportation from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) to the conference Hotels in KL.

### **By KLIA Express (ERL)**

The most convenient transportation from the Airport to the city is by the KLIA EXPRESS. Upon your arrival at KLIA, at the Arrival Hall, follow the signs for KLIA EXPRESS. Take the glass lifts on the

far side, which has KLIA EXPRESS stickers pasted on the doors. This is important, as only this lift will take you to the correct side of the building on Level 1 where the ERL counters are. The train operates at 15-minutes intervals during peak hours and 20 minutes during off-peak hours. The first train from KLIA to KL Sentral is at 5.00 am and the last train is at 1.00 am. The journey takes only 28 minutes (non-stop journey). The normal fare for a single journey from KLIA to KL Sentral is RM55.00 (13 USD) and RM110.00 for a return trip (26 USD). From KL Sentral you can choose to either take a taxi, Grab Car, UBER or the Light Train Transit (LRT) to the hotels in KL.

## **By Taxi**

Airport Limo offers taxi and limo services from Kuala Lumpur International Airport to selected areas in Kuala Lumpur. Coupons for taxis and limos can be obtained at the Airport Limo counter at the International Arrival Hall (*just after Customs*). Fares vary depending on the distance. Please seek assistance from any Airport Personnel if you fail to find the counter. For more information on KLIA Airport Limo and Taxi, go to <http://www.klia-taxi.com/index.html>.

## **By Airport Coach**

For Airport Coach, you may proceed to the KLIA bus station situated at Ground Floor Block C annexed to Main Terminal Building which is just 3 minutes walking distance from Arrival Hall exit. Please get your ticket at Airport Coach counter no. 3 at the Ground Floor of Block C. The bus will depart to KL Sentral from platform 1 KLIA bus station. The service from KLIA to KL Sentral starts at 5.30am and ends at 12.30am every day and operates at every 1-hour interval. The travelling time takes approximately one hour. The fare for one way is RM10.00 (around 2.50 USD) and RM18.00 for return trip (around 5 USD). It can be arranged for the Airport Coach to take passengers from KL Sentral to a specific hotel at extra cost.

Airport Coach known as “Baby Coach” offers direct drops and pick up from most hotels in the city. The pick-up service is an “on-call” basis. If you wish to use this service, you need to call the AIRPORT COACH and book a pick up time. Fares vary.

## **Climate**

Malaysia is a tropical country that has a steady temperature of 26°C to 34°C. There are no distinct wet or dry seasons in Malaysia. However, rainfalls are usually expected in the late afternoons. Light, comfortable clothing is recommended for outdoor activities.

Kuala Lumpur is generally safe city by day or night. Friendly police officers patrol off frequently and conduct routine checks on residents. To ensure that your stay is pleasant and hassle free, visitors are advised to carry their proof of identity (e.g., travel documents) with them at all times.

## **Getting Around Kuala Lumpur**

Visitors to Kuala Lumpur have a variety of public transportation options to choose from when travelling around the city. With the city's efficient network of Monorail, train, bus and taxi services – getting around KL is both convenient and affordable.
